

Watumull Scholarship for Study Abroad or Independent Research in India

Scholarship DEADLINE: April 15, 2013, 5:00 pm

Three scholarships of up to \$5,000 are available for undergraduate or graduate students that will be studying abroad or conducting independent research in India in summer 2013 and/or fall 2013. Students must be enrolled in an approved study abroad program or an approved independent study project in India through the University of Oregon. The scholarship awards may be used to assist the student with expenses related to the study abroad/independent study experience, including but not limited to tuition, fees, books, travel, room and board.

Eligibility requirements:

- Must be an undergraduate or graduate student who will study the culture, arts and/or languages of India
- Must be studying in India for summer 2013 and/or fall 2013
- Have at least a 3.0 GPA
- Strong application for study abroad or independent study
- Preference will be given to applicants who have not previously spent 45 days or more in India

Application Materials:

- Two page, double-spaced essay on how this scholarship will benefit you academically, professionally and personally. Please include any financial challenges you may have.
- Resume
- Unofficial DuckWeb transcript (include winter 2013 grades)
- If you are not going on a CIEE or SIT India program through the UO, please submit a copy of your study abroad application; or

If you are conducting an independent study project, please submit your independent study proposal with a statement from your UO faculty member who will be overseeing your work in India.
